## The County Assessor Values Property



By July 1 of each year, the primary responsibility of the county assessor is to determine the taxable value of each property so that each owner is assured of paying the proper amount of property tax for the support of local governments, and to publish that information in the local property assessment roll.

## Taxable real property values may be reappraised if:

A change in ownership occurs; or

New construction is completed; or

The reappraisal is part of an annual review of properties having declining value; or


A change in the use of property occurs; or

New construction is partially completed on January 1; or

The reappraisal is part of a land conservation contract (Williamson Act).



#### Where Your Taxes Go



#### **Property Tax Annual Calendar**

| January 1         | Tax Lien Date as of which ownership and value is determined   |
|-------------------|---|
| February 1        | Second installment of secured taxes due and payable   |
| April 1           | Business property statement due   |
| April 10*         | Delinquent date to pay second installment of secured tax bill.  After 5 p.m., a 10 percent penalty plus \$40.00 charge is added |
| May 7             | Last day to file Business Property Statement without penalty  |
| June 30           | Last day of fiscal year   |
| July 1            | Fiscal year begins; secured roll done   |
| July 2            | Appeals Board filing period opens   |
| August 31         | Last day to pay unsecured property tax payment without delinquency penalty  |
| September-October | Tax Collector issues annual secured tax bills   |
| November 1        | Due date to pay first installment of secured tax bill   |
| November 30       | Close of Assessment Appeals Board filing period (next business day if it falls on the weekend)                                  |
| December 10*      | Delinquent date to pay first installment of secured tax bill.  After 5 p.m., a 10 percent penalty is added.                     |




