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## FARM LABOR HOUSING LOAN PROGRAM SUMMARY

San Mateo County has established this program to help agricultural operators and landowners provide housing for very low-income farmworkers by creating new housing, rehabilitating or repairing existing housing, or replacing existing dilapidated mobile home units that have been used as farmworker housing at any time in the past. Very low-income is defined by HUD's Maximum Affordable Rent Payment Schedule posted on the website of the Department of Housing: https://www.smcgov.org/housing/income-limits (see page 2)

This program must be used to house very low-income farmworkers, who are engaged in full-time agricultural work in San Mateo County, and their families during the agricultural season. In 2023 HUD has established that very low-income in San Mateo County is:
