



Race refers to how society groups people based on their **physical traits**.




ETHNICITY


Ethnicity refers to how society groups people based on a **shared** heritage.



PRIMARY LANGUAGE




Hispanic, Latinx or Spanish origin?

Chronic Disease Management

Our primary care clinics offer team-based care for adults, teens, and children using the Chronic Care Model, which focuses on coordinated care, health promotion, and education.

Pediatric Care

We provide comprehensive health care for infants and children, including newborn physicals, asthma care, immunizations, and weight and nutrition guidance. We work closely with private hospitals to coordinate delivery and follow-up care.

Teen and Young Adult Care

In partnership with local school districts, we offer easy-access primary care for youth ages 12-25. Co-location on a school campus reduces barriers for confidential services such as birth control and mental health services.

Integrated Behavioral Health

We embed behavioral health services in our primary care clinics to help patients maintain a healthy lifestyle, overcome emotional struggles, and cope with day-to-day challenges. Our team screens for and treats a range of conditions including depression, anxiety, trauma, stress, substance use and other addictive behaviors.

Ron Robinson Senior Care Center

We provide interdisciplinary primary care for seniors ages 60 and older, including complete outpatient care focused on physical, mental, social, and lifestyle health. Patients can receive care in the clinic or in their home, if needed.

Keller Center for Family Violence Intervention

This nationally recognized center offers comprehensive forensic medical exams, crisis intervention, forensic interviews, and coordination of community services for victims of sexual assault, physical and sexual abuse, domestic violence, and elder/dependent adult abuse.

Pain Management Clinic

Our interdisciplinary team works collaboratively with the patient, taking a more holistic approach to pain management. We use the "functional restoration" model, which focuses on helping patients manage the impact of pain and improve their quality of life.

Patient treatment plans may include intensive case management, medication management, physical, occupational, and aquatic therapy, psychotherapy, and addiction referrals.


