# **MOSS Beach** SR 1 CONGESTION AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

## **Existing Conditions**

Highway 1 in Moss Beach has safety and accessibility challenges, for example:

- → Lack of stop signs, lights, or other traffic controls
- Difficulties for vehicles crossing or merging onto SR 1

### **Possible Improvements**

To improve traffic flow and safety within the project area and meet the needs of Moss Beach drivers, cyclists, pedestrians, and transit riders, the following improvements are being considered:



- $\rightarrow$  High speeds along the highway
- → Limited infrastructure for pedestrians and bicyclists
