Our efforts continue to remove surrendered and/or abandoned boats from Coyote Point Marina. Abandoned boats create a habitat for raccoons, pose a risk of sinking, and can be visually unappealing. Thanks to a renewed California Division of Boating and Waterways SAVE grant we are able to clean up our marina by removing these boats. This week we demolished three sailboats at the launch ramp. We have another seven boats that will be towed out and demolished off site. Please continue to maintain your boats so that we don't have to keep doing this!!

### **Sail to an Historic Location**

Clipper Cove is a great destination for quick weekend getaway. My wife Catherine and I go there several times each year, and it's one of our favorites. This wonderfully sheltered anchorage is located at Treasure Island, right in the middle of the Bay Bridge. It's only 12 nautical miles from Coyote Point, so it's a quick sail to get there. The cove features great holding ground, a beautiful beach, and many shoreside activities. The iconic Mersea restaurant is a 20 minute walk from the beach. Right on the cove sits the historic airline terminal, which houses the Treasure Island Museum and a newly opened tap room. Clipper Cove was the first International Airport in San Francisco, and served as the launching point for giant flying boats called "Clippers" that provided international luxury travel from 1936 to 1942. The Marina is in poor condition, and is no longer accepting visitors, so you will have to anchor. If you want to go

ashore you will need a kayak or dinghy. The lack of currents and minimal boat traffic make this a natural place for raft-ups!
