Available by-request on farms located in San Mateo County for you and your employees*

COVID-19 TESTING

- Upon your request, staff from the San Mateo County Public Health Testing Team and staff from a community based organization can come to your farm to test you and your employees.
- Typically, an individual swabs their own mouth using a Q-tip under the Testing Team's observation
- Test results are available within ~72 hours. Results are texted or emailed to the individual being tested, and a 1-800 number is also available to call to get results.
- We will bill an individual's insurance; there will be no costs passed onto the individual.
 Should someone not have insurance, they will not be turned away.

COVID-19 EDUCATION

- Educating employees about hand washing, social distancing, and available resources takes about 20-30 minutes.
- Typically, the session is done by San Mateo County's Public Health's Field Medicine
