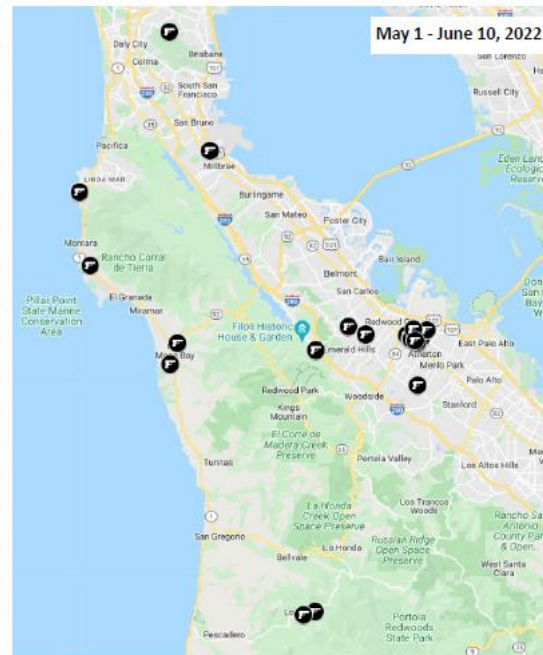
Firework and Gunfire Activity: Fourth of July Preparation

In preparation for the upcoming Fourth of July holiday, the Crime and Intelligence Analysis Unit is reviewing historical and current gunfire and firework activity within our jurisdiction. Leading up to the holiday, this report will be updated weekly so patrol is provided with the most accurate and up-to-date information.

GUNFIRE

Between May 1-June 10, the Sheriff's Office had 24 gunfire calls for service. These include ShotSpotter activations, shots fired calls, and shots fired report calls. Please note, the Sheriff's Office currently only has ShotSpotter sensors in North Fair Oaks. Out of those 24, only two generated a Sheriff's Office report number. Comparatively in 2021, there were a total of 26 gunfire related calls for service during this timeframe. There has been a slight increase in North Fair Oaks (+4) and notable decreases in Millbrae (-5) and San Carlos (-3).

North Fair Oaks

Gunfire:

Most of the gunfire activity occurred southwest of Middlefield Road. On 5/14, deputies responded to the 200 block of Berkshire Avenue following a ShotSpotter activation. Ten rounds were fired at approximately 9:48PM. A resident witnessed the suspect fire numerous rounds into the air and flee the scene (#22-03822). Following 5/14, there were four additional gunfire calls for service in this area. The immediate area of Semicircular Road/Arrowhead Lane is also an area with current and historical gunfire and firework activity during the summer months.

Earlier in May, there was a single gunfire incident at Warrington/Halsey Avenue where five spent casings were found in the middle of the street (#22-03512).

Fireworks:

Firework activity appeared to be spread out across North Fair Oaks with no apparent patterns or clusters. As noted on the previous page, there was a significant decrease in firework calls for service compared to last year.
