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Who We Are

- Grassroots, founded by local activists in May 2021
 - 50 active volunteers, 250 on mailing list
- Incorporated as a 501(c)4 in November 2021
- Endorsed by all 5 fed/state electeds,13 Mayors/ former Mayors, and dozens of elected and appointed community leaders
- Support Sheriff Office in its mission to protect and serve



Why We Need Oversight

Goal and Strategy

Goal

Establish an effective community-based Sheriff Oversight Board and Inspector General, both with subpoena power, to address resident complaints, investigate issues, and make policy and practice recommendations

Strategy

Develop and roll out a robust community based campaign to persuade the Board of Supervisors to use their legislative authority to pass an <u>ordinance</u>

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People of Color at Risk of Arrest

- From DOJ data:
 - Black people 9x more likely than White people to be arrested in San Mateo County than White people
 - Hispanic people 2x likely than White people to be arrested here as White people
- From Sheriff <u>data portal</u>:
 - July-Sept 2021
 Hispanic 25% of population, 49% of arrests
 Black 2% of population, 13% of arrests
 White 36% of population, 29% of arrests
 - Jan-Mar 2022

 Hispanic 25% of population, 45% of arrests
 Black 2% of population, 13% of arrests
 White 36% of population, 30% of arrests



People of Color At Risk of Death

- Officers in San Mateo County used tasers to kill 3 unarmed People of Color (POC) in 2018
- Despite 19 use-of-force deaths, NO officers in our county have been charged during DA Wagstaffe's tenure
- In the 5-county Bay Area, although Black people are <7% of our population; they are 27% of people killed by police, 2015-2020

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Immigrants Risked Deportation

(On 11/9/2021, Sheriff announced he would stop transfers to ICE.)

Transfers to ICE (immigration) by County, 2020:

San Mateo County turned over directly from jail to ICE more than 100 people after the California Values Act passed in 2017

Civilian Oversight Facts

220 cities and counties nationally have civilian oversight

• 25 cities/counties are in California including the following counties:

Los Angeles	San Francisco
Sacramento	Santa Clara
San Diego	Sonoma

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State law AB1185 gives subpoena power to boards & inspectors general but does not create these boards/offices



What Civilian Oversight Looks Like

- Community-based civilian Oversight Board
- Professional Inspector General
- Both appointed by County Board of Supervisors
- Both with subpoena power

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Oversight Board Composition & Duties

- 11 community members impartial, knowledgeable, committed; diverse geographically and life experience
- Monthly public meetings
- Community outreach/listening
- Receive and investigate complaints and incidents
- Subpoena power
- Review and recommend policies/public reports

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Inspector General

- Trained professional
- Investigate complaints from civilians and whistleblowers
- Investigate incidents of force including:
 - excessive force
 - deaths in custody
 - racial profiling trends
- Subpoena power
- Review and recommend policies/public reports



Must Haves

- Independent
- Strong subpoena power
- Oversight board membership reflects the diversity of the community
- Consistent support from Board of Supervisors
- Adequate funding
- Ability to take complaints directly from residents
- Access to data and records



Success Stories

Denver

- Use of force incidents during arrests dropped 21 percent
- Violent crime rate fell 8 percent after monitor's office launched
- Strong support by politicians and government leaders

New Orleans

- Formation of Use of Force Review Board
- Release bodycam footage of officer shootings w/in 10 days
- Officer-involved shootings down from 20 in 2012 to 9 in 2019

Newark, NJ

- Community engagement
- Peaceful nature of Newark's protests over Floyd's death
- Required de-escalation training

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Even With Problems, Oversight Has Impact

Sacramento County

 Sheriff blocking of Inspector General entering jail helped to motivate passage of AB 1185

Santa Clara County

 Sheriff's resistance to cooperating with oversight led to felony charges

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Limits of Civilian Oversight

 Oversight is a necessary component, but not a complete solution

CAN PROVIDE	CANNOT PROVIDE
Create transparency and accountability through public reports to Supervisors and Sheriff	Set Sheriff or Board of Supervisor policy or discipline/fire deputies

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Where Do We Go Now?

 Outreach to City Councils, community groups, labor, business, and faith community to educate and build support

 Endorsements from City Council members and other elected officials

 Work with Board of Supervisors and Sheriff-Elect to finalize an ordinance for Board to adopt
