This opening is NOT for the Housing Choice Voucher Program, but for Project-Based Voucher assisted units in the properties listed below. Applicants may apply to one or more waitlists so long as they meet the age (if applicable) and household size requirements. See Subsidy Standard\* below. **These waiting lists will be open until a sufficient number of pre-applications are received. The waiting lists are subject to close without notice.**

All completed pre-applications submitted through [www.mysmhousing.com](http://www.mysmhousing.com) during the open window will be placed on the waitlist(s). Positions on the waitlist(s) will be randomly placed by lottery. If you are unable to access the online application portal, please leave a message at (650) 802-3352 for application assistance. A Housing Authority representative will contact you. We will require your name, social security number (if available), date of birth and contact information to place your name on the applicable waiting list(s).

Preference will be given to San Mateo County residents. In addition to the income limits, other restrictions may apply. The project owners may also have additional eligibility criteria, such as lower income limits for certain units and resident suitability screening such as rental history and credit.

**\*Subsidy Standard:** HACSM will place applicants to specific unit size on the waiting list based on the following standard:

- Head of household and his/her spouse, co-head, or partner will be assigned one bedroom.
- All remaining family members will be assigned one bedroom per two family members regardless of gender, age, or relationship of these family members.
