For Immediate Release - Notice of Vacancy**Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee**

President of the Board of Supervisors Dave Pine announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee. There is currently one (1) vacancy representing the interests of Older Adults. To be eligible for this recruitment, applicants must be a resident of Supervisorial Districts 1, 2, 3 or 5 in San Mateo County. This five-member committee advises the Board of Supervisors on funding, projects, programs and policies related to improving and increasing bicycling and walking transportation, primarily within the County’s unincorporated communities. The Committee establishes the time and place of its regular meetings, and meets at least 4 times a year, unless otherwise determined by a majority vote of the Committee.

Deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, July 28, 2023 at 5 p.m.
