AB60 GUIDELINES: DRIVERS LICENSE



What is AB 60?

For individuals who are unable to provide proof of legal presence in the U.S but who meet the CA DMV requirements and are able to provide proof of identity and California Residency.

How do I apply for AB 60 DL?

- Complete a DL or identification card application
- Prepare for DL test
- Schedule an appointment at DMV
- Provide proof of identity and California Residency such as mortgage bill, employment document, rental/lease agreement, insurance document etc.
- Have your thumb print scanned, take vision test, have photo taken.
- Pass Drivers knowledge test
- Take the behind the wheel test. (Driving tests are not given without an appointment).

Applicants Under 18

Applicants under 18 will still need to provide proof that they completed drivers education.
