who can get a Real ID?

- Any Californian who can prove their current legal presence in the U.S with identity documents (original or certified copy) is eligible for a real ID.
- Includes: permanent residents, green card holder, those with temporary legal status, recipients of DACA, Temporary Protected Status, valid student or employment visa.

One Proof of Identity

- Unexpired foreign passport with valid U.S Visa and approved I-94 form.
- Valid/Unexpired Permanent Resident Card.
- Valid/Unexpired Employment Authorization Document
- Unexpired Foreign Passport
- Documents reflecting TPS benefits eligibility.

Two Proofs of CA Residency

To provide proof of residency you must present 2 documents that contain your CA physical address. For example:

- Rental or Lease Agreement with signature of owner/landlord and the tenant/resident
- Mortgage Bill
- Home Utility Bill
- Medical Documents
- Employment Documents
- Insurance Documents
- Property Tax Bill or Statement
