



#### You need to look for "Antioch-SFO+ Millbrae Line KEY: Follow the yellow line

In order for you to get to Colma you must get off at the end of the line which is "Antioch-SFO+ Millbrae .



### WHAT DO THE MACHINES LOOK LIKE?/ BUY YOUR CLIPPER CARD

### What do the machines look like ?

When you walk into the Bart Station, you will see these machines where you will be purchasing your clipper card and adding money to your clipper card.



#### If you have an iPhone or an android, you can get a clipper card and save \$3



Where will you be getting your clipper card?

This is the machine you will see at BART. On this image below you will see on the right hand side you will see numbers 1-4.



Once you have purchased your clipper card it will look like the image below.

Note: Riders ages between 5-18 Youth Clipper card by mail, email or fax. Or get a card in person. You'll need to verify your birth date with an accepted form of identification for a Youth .



## FIND YOUR FARE

In every Bart there is a "BART Fare" sign, you can calculate how much you need to put in your card or how much your card needs to have.

In this image on the right has the prices for a oneway trip or round trip, for example, if you are at the Millbrae station and you want to go to Hayward, you would only have to pay \$6.25 for one-way, or \$12.50 for round trip. Keep in mind you have to make a stop which is the Embarcadero station, but you DO NOT have pay extra. UNLESS you exit the BART station to grab a drink or food, then you would have to pay from Embarcadero to Hayward.

The image on the left show you are at the Oakland Int'l Airport. For example, if you would like to go to Downtown Berkley in the image it shows it will cost \$8.50 (The price may be different since years has gone by and this is from 2014 or it might be the same, you have to see the BART Fare sign).

Note: If you would like to know the exact price and if you have a smart for (iPhone/Android you can go on the website.

### FARE GATES: SCAN YOUR CLIPPER CARD TO ENTER.



Once you are done getting your clipper card/adding money to your clipper card, you will see the big sign "Bart Entrance" you will have to go through these gates in order to ride the train.

With your clipper card or your smart phone, you can scan on top of the blue circle that will say "clipper card" to ensure that you have money in your card to ride the train



### ESCALATORS/ ELEVATORS



To get to your train, you will need to take the escalator.



If you are unable to take the escalator, there will be elevators you can take, to go on the train or to exit the train stations. Look out for elevator signs.



If you cannot find the elevators, look for "Elevator" signs or look for exit signs as well. If you are still unable to find the elevators go to the station agent. The station is there to help you in anything you need/ any question you have regarding your ride on BART.

## BOARDING THE CORRECT TRAIN



Once you use the escalator/elevators, you will see that there is two sides, meaning two trains come, sometimes at the same time. Do not feel overwhelmed if you do not know which train to ride on. ALWAYS look out for these signs on the image below, if you know your destination is Millbrae, you will be going on the side where it says Millbrae.



The signs will help you on which train to ride on. Also you can ask the station agent before you get on. To really calm your nerves, you can always ask the person right next to you.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR DURING YOUR RIDE?



During your ride you may here the driver say each stop that they make, for example, if you are stopping in Millbrae, they will say "you are now in Millbrae station" and they will open the doors, for you or other people who need to get off this station


The image to your right will show signs, you will need to look out for when you are riding on BART. Once the driver opens the train doors, you will see these kinds of signs, if your destination is Oakland International Airport, the sign will show that. Again, the driver will announce it as well.



### **EXITING BART** Finally! You made it to your destination!

The Same Way You Came In, is the same way you are coming out. To exit you have to scan your clipper card or smart phone.









Depending on the BART station, once you exit you will find stairs that go down where it leads to the outside. If you cannot use stairs, please look out for the elevator's.



As you are leaving the train, you want to see the EXIT signs, they will be in green most of the time, if not they will have signs that has "EXIT" above by stairs.



Each station will have stairs going up or down to exit. An example in the image below, where you can find stairs going up to exit is in San Francisco.

#### **MORE INFO**



- Bart no longer uses Bart Tickets, ONLY Clipper Cards. Clipper cards are a onetime purchase of \$3.00. If you have a smart phone, you can have it in your apple wallet or on a android too
- All BART stations sell Clipper cards through automatic vending machines that accept nickels, dimes, quarters and \$1 coins, as well as \$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills.
  - Station agent: Station Agents are available to answer questions and offer assistance with fares, schedules, and other information. Also Go to the Station Agent booth if you feel lost.
- There is priority seating to the left of the door on all trains for seniors and people with disabilities. All trains can also accommodate wheelchair users to the right of the doorway.
  - Restrooms: Nearly all stations have public restrooms.
