- Conducted 4 workshops in person
- 2 business planning sessions (10 weeks each)
- 1 business startup training (4 weeks each)
- Served 21 North Fair Oaks residents; Served 69 residents from Menlo Park and Redwood City
- 15 North Fair Oaks residents received technical training; 29 Redwood City residents received technical training
- 1 North Fair Oaks resident received a \$5,000 grant; 8 Redwood City residents received \$45,000 in *Seed Grants
- Developed 4 websites for North Fair Oaks business owners

Clients Served

Q4 -49 clients served

- 75% (37) women
- **78% (38) hispanics** & immigrant backgrounds
- 82% (40) are extremely-low to moderate-income

Q1-41 clients served

- 57% (23) women
- 95% (39) hispanics & immigrant backgrounds
- 100% (41) are extremely-low to moderate-income
