

# Unincorporated Areas in the SBWMA Serviced By Recology




## County Role in SBWMA

- Set Rates Annually
- Ensure Contractor Compliance with the Franchise Agreement
- Make Program Recommendations and Conduct Special Events
- Manage Customer Feedback
- One member of a 11 Member Agency



### History of Rate Increases

#### NFO: Historical Rate Adjustments



#### Rate Setting Process

- Annual Audit of Revenue and Costs
- Apply Indices such as CPI
- The SBWMA Allocates the Costs to Member Agencies
- Review Surplus or Shortfalls in Revenue
- The County Conducts an Independent Analysis of Rate Recommendations
- Final Rate Recommendation is considered by the Board of Supervisors for Approval

### This Rate Year Steps

- On Sept 28, 2023, the SBWMA report indicated a 19.3% revenue increase was needed in CSA-8,
- At the same Board meeting, Board members voted to use a one-time Rate Stabilization Fund; this reduced the overall increase to 16.9%,
- The County further evaluated and is exercising a Cap and Carry Forward provision with Recology, it Caps certain indexes this rate year and adds the balance to next,
- The final step the County has taken is using a portion of a surplus to buy down the rate.

#### Garbage and Recycling Services

- Residential Weekly Curbside Collection of Garbage, Recycling and Organics
- Commercial Weekly Collection of Garbage and Recycling
- Disposal Fees and Handling Costs
- "On-Call" Bulky Waste Collection for Residential Customers (Two Times Per Calendar Year)
- Collection of Other Items at curb: Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters, Christmas Trees, Illegal Dumping
- Annual Confidential Document Shredding Event
- Shoreway: Free Drop off of: Recycling, Latex Paints
   Mattresses, Cooking and Motor Oil, Electronics,
   Small Appliances (blender, curling iron)

#### **SB 1383 Requirements for County Areas**

#### **Residential:**

- Residents in are required to participate in the County organics curbside collection service.
- Residents are required to properly sort their organic waste into the correct containers.

#### **Businesses:**

- Business are required to subscribe to and participate in their jurisdiction's organics curbside collection service; or
- Self-haul organic waste to a certified composting facility, all receipts will be verified.
- Certain businesses will be required to participate in an edible food recovery program.
