





# **Existing Parking Issues**

- Street Sweeping
- Curb painting






# Parking Complaints Map

## **Permit Program Details**

- Requires wide neighborhood support
  - Petition of 50% addresses in area
  - Area must show severe parking impact, avg on-street occupancy over 80%
  - City-issued survey, require
    25% response with at least
    67% in support.






# Residential Permit Parking Considerations

- 1. Is there wide support for a program?
- 2. What kind of impacts is the neighborhood experiencing?
- 3. What are the right restrictions?
- 4. Program may have impacts on the following residential situations:
  - Residents with multiple vehicles for one property
  - Home-base businesses
  - Garage not used for parking
  - Inoperable vehicles, boats, and RVs
  - Multiple families in single-family homes
- 5. What kind of enforcement is available and what are the enforcement expectations?
