## **About the Program**


The **County Talent Accelerator** is a pilot program designed to provide development, guidance, and support to County non-management staff looking to advance their careers at the County. By enhancing the core skills needed for growth within our organization, cohort graduates will be equipped to catapult themselves professionally based on their desired career goals.

Via this pilot program, for the first time ever, **Professional Coaching** will be made available to non-management staff! Graduates will become eligible to be matched up with a coach who will offer 1:1 guidance, and will assist with applying learnings to a real world setting. This will be an exceptional opportunity to hone individual skillsets and bring personal career pathways to life.

The Talent Accelerator will be taught by internal subject matter experts from the County. The program is composed of five primary learning sessions, with additional experiential modules scheduled in between sessions. The 2024 program will be held **100% in-person** in **Redwood City** and will run from **September through December 2024.** 

If selected, program attendance is critical. Participants may miss **no more than one session**. Participants who miss two or more sessions will be **withdrawn** from the program. No make ups will be provided, and virtual attendance options will not be made available. Please ensure your availability based on the program schedule on the following page.
