

- Lead Poisoning is 100% preventable!






Home visit and assessment completed

Lead Paint Settlement

- 20 years, 10 Jurisdictions,
 3 Paint Manufacturers
- \$11.7 million through 2025
- Funds must be used to:
 - Remediate lead paint in residential housing focusing on low-income individuals
 - Educate the public about lead paint hazards and the remediation program








CalEnviroScreen 4.0 Children's Lead Risk from Housing
