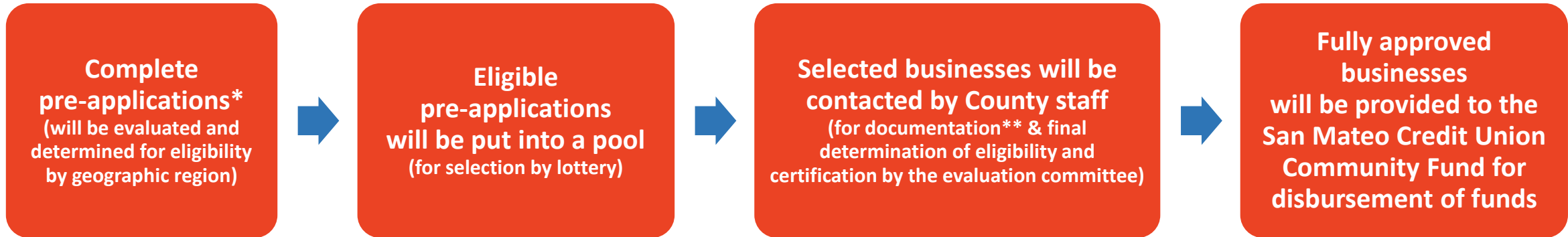

Application Evaluation Process



Defined application window, NOT first-come, first-served



- Incomplete applications will NOT be processed and ineligible applications will NOT be considered -

*Applicants will NOT be required to submit documentation during the *initial, pre-application process*

** *Copy of a valid City Business License (if a license is offered), Copy of W-9, 2019 and 2020 tax returns for the business, photo ID(s) for at least 51% of owner/partners/managing parties, COVID-19 impact statement legal residency is not a condition of approval, and no information will be shared with other government agencies*

Pre-Application Opens on Friday, October 29th at 8:00AM

County of San Mateo Small Business Grant Program: Round 6

The San Mateo County Board of Supervisors recently approved a new round of grants to help small businesses that have not received any assistance from the County, State, or Federal COVID-19-related programs in the past 12 months.

The Program will distribute 200 grants of \$10,000 each to small businesses that meet the following criteria:

- Business has not received a County small business grant or State or Federal small business COVID recovery grant or loan in the past 12 months;
- Demonstrate that the business was negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by providing tax returns from 2019 and 2020 including IRS Schedule C or Form 1065;
- Had a gross income of \$120,000 or less in 2019;
- Had 10 or fewer employees in 2019;
- Currently occupy a physical business space in San Mateo County;
- Has a valid business license if one is offered and any other permitting licenses such as Environmental Health, State ABC, etc.;
- If the business is a franchise, is independently owned and operated by a County resident, or 50% or more of the franchise ownership group must be comprised of County residents.

Legal residency is not a condition of approval and no information will be shared with other government agencies.

The following criteria will disqualify any applicant:

- Nonprofit entity
- Business cannot provide all required documents
- Business has received any Federal, State or County loans or grants in the past 12 months
- Business operates out of a home or non-commercial space

Eligible applicants will be selected at random from the pool of eligible applicants at the conclusion of the application window.

If selected, applicants must be prepared to provide the following documents:

- IRS Form W9
- IRS Tax Returns – 2019 & 2020 Form 1040 Including Schedule C or Form 1065
- City/Town Business License (if applicable)
- Photo (ID) of establishment owner(s)/partner(s)/principal(s)

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS, INCORRECT INFORMATION, OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION.

Categories of Potential Applicants



Will provide grants of up to \$10,000 each to qualifying establishments:



NO COUNTY, STATE, FEDERAL FUNDING

- Business* has not received a County small business grant or State or Federal small business COVID recovery grant or loan in the past 12 months



IMPACTED BY COVID-19

- Demonstrate that the business was negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by providing completed tax returns from 2019 and 2020 (including IRS Schedule C or Form 1065) and a COVID-19 Impact Statement
- Lawfully operated** prior to March 11, 2020, when a local state of emergency was proclaimed due to the COVID-19 pandemic



ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY

- Had a gross income of \$500,000 or less in 2019, or \$1,000,000 or less in 2019 if a food-related business
- 10 or fewer employees in 2019;
- Fully compliant with applicable regulations
- Applicant must possess and present copy of government-issued photo id

The application portal opened on Friday, October 29th at 8:00AM and will remain open until Friday, November 12th at 5:00PM

*Currently occupy a physical business space in San Mateo County (if the business is a franchise, is independently owned and operated by a County resident, or 50% or more of the franchisee ownership must be comprised of County residents)

**Establishments that have changed ownership since March 11, 2020, and otherwise meet the Program criteria above are eligible.

What Types of Businesses DO NOT Qualify for the Grant?



Applicants will be ***ineligible*** for a grant from the Program under the following circumstances:



Incomplete applications



Failure to meet the eligibility criteria outlined



They are a **non-profit entity**



The applicant's establishment **has received or been approved for a grant from any of the following programs:**

- Small business relief program managed by Renaissance Entrepreneurship Center, approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 20, 2020 (Resolution 077791)
- *San Mateo County Strong Fund Small Business Grant* administered by the Community Fund, approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 10, 2020 (Resolution 077828)
 - Recipients of grants from **earlier** *San Mateo County Strong* grant programs *are eligible* for the Program
- *San Mateo County Restaurant, Brewery & Winery Grant Program*
- *San Mateo County Technology Grant*
- **Any other Federal or State COVID Relief loans or grants**, in the past 12 months, such as
 - U.S. Small Business Administration *Paycheck Protection Program*
 - U.S. Small Business Administration COVID-19 *Economic Injury Disaster Loan*
 - *California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program*

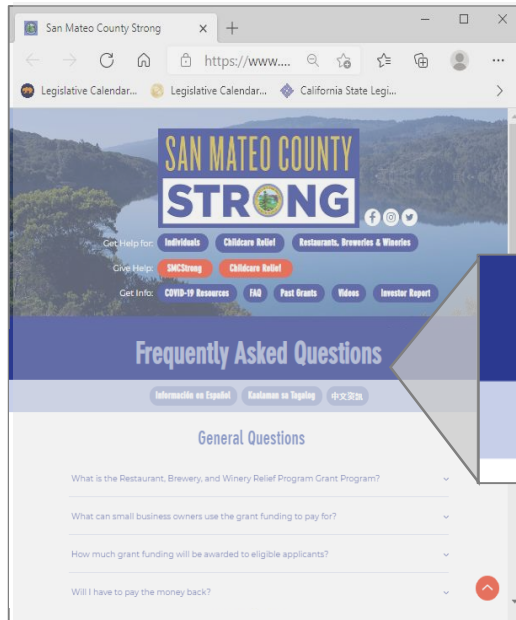

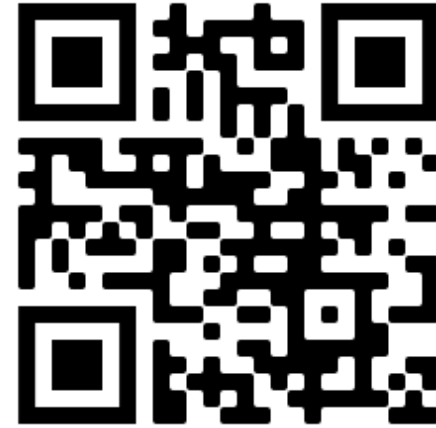
