Dear Water User:

Due to the low flow condition of the San Gregorio Creek, this notice requests that you not divert water from the stream system for <u>3 days</u> of each week (until further notice), beginning Friday, August 28, 2009, according to your Point of Diversion Number, as set forth in the following schedule:
