## **Refresher on Marina Policies**

As your Marina staff, we want to be sure that all members of our community are aware of several key Marina rules that seem to consistently be ignored.

Please be sure you are using 30-amp outdoor rated shore power cords. Lightweight cords can short out and cause fires.

Please do not store vehicles in the Marina lots. If you need to keep a car here for more than three nights in a row check with the office.

Swimming is not allowed in the harbor.

All vessels must have current registration and insurance. Note that for many CA DMV registered boats it's time to renew!

Here's a good one – right from the posted rules on our web site – "All boats shall be berthed with proper care and equipment and shall be maintained at all times as to safety and appearance." Those of you who have moss factories above decks and lush gardens below the waterline – it's time to get your boat cleaned up!
