SUBJECT: Annual Informational Commemorative Facility Report

RECOMMENDATION:

Accept informational report about newly dedicated commemorative benches.

BACKGROUND:

The Parks Department accepts donations for the dedication of commemorative benches to recognize or memorialize individuals, groups, or significant historical individuals or events provided that such individuals or events were related to the park unit or local community. Appendix B of the "Guidelines for Donation, Memorial and Sponsorship Contributions" describes commemorative bench donations, types of benches, plaque wording, location of benches, term of donation, qualifying donations and re-dedication.

Annually, the Department provides an Annual Report to the Parks and Recreation Commission of dedicated or re-dedicated benches.

DISCUSSION:

The Parks Department maintains a Master List of available and dedicated bench sites throughout the Park System. Of the 201 available bench sites, 118 are now dedicated with several new dedications underway for Coyote Point Recreation Area, San Bruno Mountain and Sawyer Camp Trail.
